



Peninsula Electric Cooperative, Inc. (PENELCO) in compliance with DOE Department Circular No. DC 2017-12-0015, "Promulgating the Rules and Guidelines Governing the Establishment of the Renewable Portfolio Standards for On-Grid Areas", is in the process of preparing for the Competitive Selection Process (CSP) on the procurement of 10MW Renewable Energy for Power Supply Agreement.

In compliance with DOE Department Circular No. DC 2018-02-003, "Adopting and Prescribing the Policy of Competitive Selection Process in the Procurement by the Distribution Utilities of Power Supply Agreement for the Captive Market", as amended, PENELCO is looking for two (2) captive customer representatives to become a member of the PENELCO Third Party Bids and Awards Committee (TPBAC) with the qualifications specified below. The TPBAC shall spearhead and manage the CSP and shall comply with the policy and procedures in the conduct of the CSP provided in DC 2018-02-003 as amended. The TPBAC shall be accountable for its decision in the conduct of the CSP.

- A. Qualifications for Technical Person (TPBAC Member)
 1. Must be a resident within PENELCO's franchise area.
 2. Must be a PENELCO member in good standing.
 3. Must be a licensed Electrical Engineer preferably with Masteral Degree.
 4. Must be knowledgeable in the new reforms and challenges in the Power Industry,
 5. Proficient in written and oral English and the local dialect.
 6. Ability to exercise mature judgment in critical decision making.

- B. Qualifications for Lawyer (TPBAC Member)
 1. Must be a resident within PENELCO's franchise area.
 2. Must be a PENELCO member in good standing.
 3. Must be a bonafide member of the Integrated Bar of the Philippines.
 4. Must be compliant with the requirements on MCLE.
 5. Must be knowledgeable in the new reforms and challenges in the Power Industry,
 6. Ability to exercise mature judgment in critical decision making.
 7. Experience in handling Power Supply Agreements is an advantage.

- C. Qualifications for Finance Officer or Accountant that has knowledge in electricity pricing (TPBAC Member)
 1. Must be a resident within PENELCO's Franchise Area
 2. Must be a PENELCO member in good standing
 3. Have been engaged in the practice of finance or accountancy for at least fifteen (15) years.
 4. Have been engaged in the practice of finance or accountancy in the electric power industry for at least five (5) years.
 5. If a licensed certified public accountant, be in good standing with the Philippine Institute of Certified Public Accountants.
 6. Must be knowledgeable in the new reforms and challenges in Power Industry.
 7. Proficient in written and oral English and the local dialect.
 8. Ability to exercise mature judgment in critical decision making.

Note: If none qualifies the alternative option to complete the line-up of two (2) customer representatives of TPBAC shall comply with DC 2021-10-0030.
